## **More About Wikis**

A wiki is an easy-to-edit, collaborative way to create a website. Our wiki will be "protecte," meaning that anyone can see our work, but only the students participating in the project can actually edit and add to the wiki. One exciting aspect of a wiki is that students from all over the world can collaborate on the same wiki. This means that our students here at ISB can create a wiki in partnership with other fourth grade students around the world.
